**SUBJECT:** Measure RR Safe Routes to BART Grant Program - Update

In a May 26, 2023 memo, BART staff informed the BART Board on Measure RR Safe Routes to BART (SR2B) Cycle 2 awards that were approved by the General Manager. On one of the proposals, the City of El Cerrito's application requested \$812,977 for an El Cerrito del Norte Complete Streets project. This project was awarded funds, however the Board memo mistakenly identified the award amount as \$1.5 M for the project. BART staff has discussed this oversight with City staff, and the City has confirmed that only the requested amount will be included in the pass-through agreement. Below is the revised chart.
