

Station Profiles – Home Origin Maps

The following station maps depict home origin locations of weekday BART customers who travel to the station from home. The maps are based on data from BART's 2008 Station Profile Study. The report text and data tables are available in a separate PDF file at www.bart.gov/profile.

The points on each map are color coded by mode of access to the BART station. The points are weighted to reflect average weekday ridership at the station. For example, an origin point with a weight of seven will appear on the map as seven points, randomly dispersed around the actual point of origin. Note that the number of trips may be underrepresented in cases where multiple trips originate at the same location. Refer to *Appendix B* of the 2008 Station Profile Study report for geocoding details.





North Concord / Martinez Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





North Berkeley Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





Orinda Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





Pittsburg / Bay Point Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





Pleasant Hill Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





Powell St. Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode



Richmond Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode




Rockridge Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





San Bruno Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





San Leandro Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





South Hayward Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





South San Francisco Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode





Union City Station: Home Locations of BART Riders by Mode




